Conditions:

- A Temporary Water Use Permit will be issued upon approval by the District Manager or his designated representative.
- A Temporary Water Use Permit must be issued for the use of District water for irrigation, dust control, directional boring,
- The rights-of-way shall in no way be adverse to the District’s operation and maintenance programs, policies or goals.
- No previously authorized use of the rights-of-way is adversely affected by the proposed activities.
- There is an absence of current violations of District rules be either the owner or contractor.
- The Permittee shall be responsible for the repair or restoration of any damage to the District’s rights-of-way which result from the permitted use. Such restoration shall be to original or better condition.
- Upon completion of the rights-of-way usage the Permittee shall contact the District (239-368-0044) for final inspection. If required, the Permittee must pay for any re-inspection fees needed because the project was not ready for final inspection.
- The Temporary Water Use Permit will expire **two (2) weeks** from the date of issue.
- A 24-hour notice shall be given prior to any required inspections.
